1. How do I get credit for an internship?

2. How many hours do I need to complete to earn credit?

For every **60 hours** worked at the internship during the semester, students may earn **ONE** unit of academic credit:

- 1 unit of credit (60 hours total)
- 2 units of credit (120 hours total)
- 3 units of credit (180 hours total)
- 4 units of credit (240 hours total)

3. Can I register for an internship class myself?
